
Independent oversight of the CPN through an elected Board.

- Provide a forum to share best practice. The CPN facilitates opportunities to collaborate to support people to find work.
- Act as a voice for the community. The CPN has a say in the delivery of large employment support programmes through a CPN Board.

What is Restart?

The new **£2.9 billion Restart scheme** was announced in November 2020, and will help more than 1.4 million people who have been out of work for at least 12 months enhanced support to find jobs in their local area. Restart will break down any employment barriers, integrate **local support services** and engage with employers, local government and other partners to deliver tailored support for individuals.

Maximus UK is currently bidding for the opportunity to deliver Restart across **South and West Yorkshire, Derbyshire and Nottinghamshire**, collaborating with local partners to provide innovative solutions to respond to current labour market challenges.
