

FACES - (Family and Adult Community Education Services)

We teach accredited and non-accredited courses for adults aged 19 years and over in community settings, across Sheffield. Our courses run throughout the year, term time only.

You can enrol if you:

- are aged 19 years+
- have the right to live and work in the UK
- have lived in the UK for 6 months if seeking asylum
- are not doing the same funded course with another provider

Courses are fully funded if you:

- are earning less than £25,750 gross annual salary in 2025/26 or
- are in receipt of means tested benefits
- don't already have a Level 2 qualification

Functional maths, English and digital courses are **free** for all adults who don't already have a qualification at level 2 in these subjects.
